# Local Lockdown

The key things you need to know about the new restrictions in Swansea, coming into force from 6pm Sunday 27th September.

You cannot visit or leave the county without a "reasonable excuse" such as:

- For work, if you cannot work from home
- For education
- For buying essentials like food or medicine
- To provide or receive emergency assistance
- To meet a legal obligation, and to access or receive public services
- To avoid injury or illness or escape a risk of harm
- To visit family or close friends on compassionate grounds

You can no longer form, or be in, an extended household



This means meeting indoors with anyone who is not part of your household (people you live with) is not allowed at the moment, unless you have a good reason, such as providing care to a vulnerable person

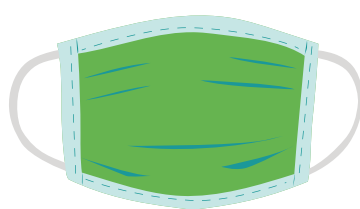


Grandparents providing informal childcare can continue with this if there are no alternatives

Restaurants, bars etc can open but you can only sit inside these places with members of your household



All licensed premises will have to stop serving alcohol at 10pm



Everyone aged 11 and over must wear face coverings in indoor places, such as shops, which are open to the public.

You should continue to work from home if at all possible
