First Minister Mark Drakeford has announced that Wales is to enter a period of intensive lockdown from Friday, 23 October until Monday, 9 November

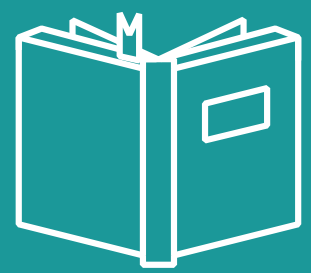


The key rules you need to know:



Pubs, restaurants and non-essential shops will shut

Leisure businesses, community centres, libraries and recycling centres will close



All indoor and outdoor gatherings with people not from a single household are banned

Places of worship will be closed for normal services, except for funerals and weddings



Primary schools will reopen after half term but secondaries will shut for all but years 7 and 8
