

# Local Lockdown Business Fund

This is a fund to provide financial help for businesses facing operational and financial challenges caused by restrictions imposed in their local area as a result of COVID-19.

21

Businesses can apply for this fund when their local area has been in lockdown for a minimum of 21 days.

28

Applications will be open in each local area on or shortly after the 28th day of local restrictions having been in place, and will be administered by your Local Authority.

40

Business must be able to demonstrate a drop in turnover greater than 40% as a result of the local lockdown restrictions

## The fund consists of 2 separate grants:

### 1 – Local Lockdown Non Domestic Rate Grant

This grant is available to businesses liable for paying business rates.

A grant of £1,500 is being made available for retail, leisure and hospitality businesses occupying properties with a rateable value of between £12,001 and £51,000.

A grant of £1,000 is being made available to businesses eligible for small business rates relief (SBRR) in Wales with a rateable value of £12,000 or less.

You are NOT eligible for this grant if you are eligible for, or have received, the Local Lockdown Discretionary Grant from your Local Authority

### 2 – Local Lockdown Discretionary Grant

A grant of £1,500 is being made available for retail, leisure and hospitality businesses that do not pay business rates.

A grant of £1,000 is being made available for businesses not in the retail, leisure and hospitality sector and do not pay business rates

You are NOT eligible for this grant if you are eligible for, or have received, the Local Lockdown Non-Domestic Rate Grant from your Local Authority

Applications will be dealt with on a first come first served basis. This may lead to applications not being appraised after they have been submitted if the fund is fully committed.
