

Hospitality: The new rules for Wales

There will be new rules in place for the hospitality sector in Wales when the firebreak lockdown ends on the 9th November 2020.



Up to four people from different households will be able to meet in cafés and pubs



A group of more than 4 people from the same household can visit these places together



All businesses (including supermarkets and off licences) must stop selling alcohol at 10pm



All food and drink should be consumed at tables



Face coverings must be worn other than when seated to eat or drink



Customers will need to give contact details for purposes of tracing people in the event of an outbreak being linked to the venue



There will be no live music and TV broadcasts will need to be kept at a low volume

Visits to pubs and cafes will be subject to strict protections discussed with the hospitality sector including:

- advance booking
- time-limited slots
- verified identification



All shops, gyms, and other premises normally open to the public but which were required to close during the fire-break can also reopen from 9th November
