

Non Domestic Rate Grant

The Dec 2020 Restrictions Business Fund: NDR Grant has been extended to cover the restrictions in place for Feb and March 2021

Businesses that have received grants during December and January 2021 do not need to reapply and will be paid an additional grant automatically

There are 3 grant schemes available, to provide direct support principally to hospitality businesses

Grant A: £3,000

For hospitality, tourism and leisure businesses, hospitality tourism and leisure supply chain businesses (e.g. suppliers of the food a restaurant cooks and sells) and retail businesses that:

- occupy premises with a Rateable Value of £12,000 or less AND
- experience a greater than 40% reduction in turnover for December 2020 compared to December 2019 as a direct result of the additional restrictions.

Grant B: £5,000

For hospitality, tourism and leisure businesses, hospitality tourism and leisure supply chain businesses (e.g. suppliers of the food a restaurant cooks and sells) and retail businesses that:

- occupy premises with a Rateable Value between £12,001 and £51,000 AND
- experience a greater than 40% reduction in turnover for December 2020 compared to December 2019 as a direct result of the additional restrictions

Grant C: £5,000

(this group have not been eligible for previous Non-Domestic Rates grants)

- For hospitality, tourism and leisure businesses occupying hereditaments with a Rateable Value between £51,001 and £500,000.
- For not-for-profit organisations occupying eligible hospitality properties with a Rateable Value between £51,001 and £500,000.
- This grant will also be available to hospitality, tourism and leisure supply chain businesses (e.g. suppliers of the drinks & snacks sold by a pub) and retail businesses that:
 1. occupy premises with a Rateable Value between £51,001 and £500,000 AND
 2. experience a greater than 40% reduction in turnover for December 2020 compared to December 2019 as a direct result of the additional restrictions.
