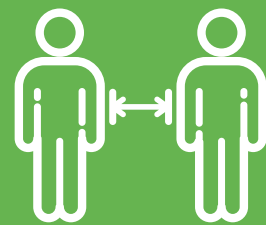


Hospitality: The new rules for businesses in Wales

These are the new rules that will be in place for the hospitality sector in Wales from 26th April 2021



Up to six people from different households will be able to meet outdoors at cafés and pubs



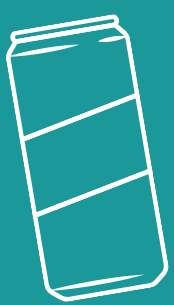
Customers from different households must still follow social distancing rules



All food and drink should be consumed at tables



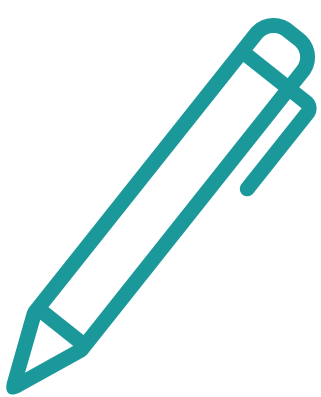
Face coverings must be worn other than when seated to eat or drink



Drinking outside of designated areas (beer gardens) is not allowed



There will be no live music and TV broadcasts will need to be kept at a low volume



Customers must give their contact details for track and trace.
