

What lockdown rules are changing in Wales?

From Saturday 17 July Wales will move to alert level 1:



Up to six people can meet indoors and organised indoor events can take place with up to 1,000 people seated and up to 200 standing



Restrictions will be relaxed around children's residential activity centres

Ice rinks will be able to reopen



There will be no limit on the amount of people who can gather outdoors in Wales - and we will no longer have to social distance when outdoors

From 7th August Wales will move to Alert Level 0 if it is safe to do so:

- No legal limits on the number of people who can meet others
- All businesses and premises will be able to reopen
- Face masks will be required in shops, on public transport and when accessing health care, but not in hospitality or education
- People who are fully vaccinated won't need to self-isolate if they are a close contact of someone who has tested positive
- Pubs will no longer be obliged to provide table service
