

Covid restrictions in Wales

New rules coming into place
on Saturday 7th August 2021

No limit on the
number of
people who can
meet up

All businesses and
premises can
reopen - including
nightclubs

Double-vaccinated people & under 18s
won't have to self-isolate if they come
into contact with someone with Covid

Laws requiring
social distancing
indoors, including
in workplaces,
will end

Face coverings won't
be legally required
in hospitality
settings where food
and drink is served

Face coverings must still be used on
public transport, in shops, and in
health and social care settings

You should still:

- meet outside where possible
- let fresh air into indoor spaces
- get tested even for mild symptoms,
and self-isolate when you are required
to do so
- keep your distance when out and work
from home whenever you can
